Water Detention & Water Logging

The monsoon is now over with the ensuing winter season. The municipality is pleased to inform that water detention time could be significantly reduced, with no major flooding taking place at critical location prone to water logging in the past. The reason was the timely and successful implementation of suitable action plan by the municipality including desilting, sludge removing etc. The final aim is to make the detention time to 'ZERO' so that no flooding could take place in the future. Currently planning is going on to achieve this for the next monsoon and preparation has already started well before time. This would be done in collaboration with the centre and the state government along with the municipality playing an active part.



Road Repairs


Frequent road repair within the municipal area is one of the regular job that the municipality udertakes, each year before the Puja and festival season. While a significant resource is spent for the job, the outcome remains temporary, since these are mainly patch repair works which eventually worn out with time, and the quality of the road returning to its initial condition. This year it was avoided and instead approximately 6 Crores is likely to be utilized for construction of entire stretch of the road, along with laying of adjacent drains, water lines and other utility lines. This will be ongoing to ensure the overall development of the municipal area and rendering quality services to the citizens.




Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojna

(HFA)

Another important project initiated during the last quarter was the Housing for all mission also known as the Pradhanmantri Aawas Yojana, with the aim of providing permanent houses to the needy, who cannot afford a proper roof over their head. During the initial phase a total of 300 houses are to be built for the residents of municipality, selected strictly according to the criteria which makes them eligible.



Proportionate funds has already been received by the municipality and the beneficiary contribution is awaited. Each beneficiary is required to open a new bank account where the total individual contribution would be transferred for starting construction of the building. More beneficiary would be identified for the next phases. The government has promised fund for future allocation of such beneficiaries as determined to be eligible for this project.



Parks



Greening of the Kamarhati municipal area has been a major push by the municipality. In view of the same currently 10 number of parks are renovated/constructed under the AMRUT project for the 2015-16 year period. A total of 50 lacs was allocated for this project, with the entire

amount spent on the same. The AMRUT project has already allocated an equal amount of fund for the next financial year of 2016-17 for developing two more parks for this new period. This would greatly help the municipality towards its aim of creating quality urban green spaces in the city to give relief from the highly congested developments and contribute to the urban aesthetics and design of the city.






Swachh Bharat and Nirmal Bangla mission

The municipality takes great pride to declare Kamarhati Municipality as an open defecation free town, which was declared on the 29th of September by the Honourable Chief Minster Smt. Mamata Banerjee, when North 24 Parganas was declared an Open defecation Free district along with three other district. Lead by the Chairman the municipal staff worked hard along with the ward councillors to attain this honour within a tight schedule. In addition to this we would like to thank the beneficiaries of Kamarhati for giving their full cooperation in making it possible, and also it would be our responsibility to keep our municipality as an open defecation free area in the foreseeable future. The municipality would do its best in addressing any related issue to help the vulnerable population in need of sanitary latrines, under the Nirmal Banlga alias Swachh Bharat Mission project. Sufficient fund has been received by the municipality for successful implementation of the project, and more funds has been promised as and when required for construction of sanitary latrines for households. the targeted Anv households in need of a proper latrine could approach the municipality for help with the same, and the municipality would construct appropriate latrine on receiving a minor contribution of Rs.1000 from the beneficiary. The total allocation including beneficiary contribution for each latrine is Rs.10,990. This is estimated for the current design of Twin Pt latrine. However it has been our observation that the citizens are more interested in septic tank oriented latrine rather than twin pit latrines. The beneficiary could add




more fund in addition to the above mentioned allocation and build any design he would want.



NUHM

There has been a special focus on health of the urban residents of the Kamarhati Municipality. The four existing Health Administrative Units (HAU-indicated in red circles) are undergoing repair with a projected budget of approximately 5.2 lacs each, while 2 new PHS (Public Health Center) are being constructed each of 20,000 sqft floor area which will be completed within 9 months. These HAU's are planned to cater to the need of almost 75% of the population of DP Nagar area and 25% of the population of the municipality.

Solid Waste Management

Planning is going on to address issues on Sewage and Solid waste management. As a part of this the municipality has found out the clogging of water channel bu plastics has been a major ongoing challenge. Currently plastic from the municipal waste collected is segregated by rag pickers from the dumping ground, and there is no formal process, though bins are already in place to collect waste products at the bank of Ganga, where all kinds of waste gets mixed. TO address this issue the municipality is preparing an action plan to put a proper segregation process in place. This would make it possible to recycle the plastic waste and utilize in road construction, conversion into liquid fuel, plasma pyrolysis and co-processing in cement kilns etc. Following table provided some statistical data on the disposal of the Kamarhati municipality:
