and clarification:

Dear Sir,

With reference to the captioned subject matter & telephonic conversation I like to clarify the following:

Complaint lodged by my next door neighbour Mrs. Sutapa Chha with regard to chopping of branches of trees & cleaning her residence backyard is justifiable.

Reasons are mentioned below:

- 1) For past 3 years we are doing this activity just to maintain cleanliness in spite of several reminders / requests petitioner has not taken the initiative to clean and maintain their backyard.
- 2) It will not be out of track to mention that both of her parents got affected with Dengue fever and unfortunately her father Mr. Shyamal Kandi Chha expired due to the same disease.
- 3) After petitioner's father's death the lone family member i.e. her mother left the house & started residing with Mrs. Sutapa Chha at a different location as she was already married.
- 4) Her (mother's) absence aggravated the poor maintenance of the house and its backyard and compelled us to maintain at our own cost for the sake of prevention from mosquito borne

diseases / snake / mongoose (biyi) / wild cat disturbances.

- 5) In the last year a honey comb formation took place and the honey bee disturbed us vehemently. While requested to take measure no action was taken by the said petitioners. I had to call professional pest killers to get rid of the same.
- 6) Apart from the above daily / regular upkeepment is needed as the dried fallen leaves lead to the clogging of our drainage system.

- 7) All the above points mentioned are not only related to my daily life but also for the adjacent neighbours. Same sort of cleaning / upkeepment activities have been done by them also.

Above activities carried out by me or by other neighbours without any complaint to any external authority keeping petitioners privilege in mind. But now as the petitioners himself has gone to lodge complaint to external authority for unnecessary harassment of us, time has come to go ahead for joint counter petition and exposing the petitioners baseless argument / complaint.

Hope you will understand the concern and take proper action regarding the matter and help us to lead a hygienic disease free life style by issuing proper written instruction to the petitioners for the maintenance of their house as well as backyard in future.
