Notes:- As per previous year the emergent staff Viz- Ambulance, Water pumping station & Darwans will be allowed compensatory leave for the holidays declared with triple as Terisk mark if engaged on duty on the declared holidays or rest day, concerned depart-Mental in charge will allow compensatory leave to their employees preferably within 3 Months from the date of each holidays or rest day.

On the question of allowing compensatory leave the procedure should be followed Strictly that compensatory leave will not be allowed in combination with or in Continuation with any other leave except casual leave. In the year 2013 the Municipal office (Indoor & Outdoor) declared to be closed 'Ratha Jatra' local festival date will be notified later on.

General Instructions to be followed in all types of holidays including holidays for the Muslim Festivals.

1) No substitute holidays should be allowed if any of the festival holidays initially notified Subsequently happens to fall on a weekly off any other non; working day or in the event Of more than one festival falling on the same day.

2) If there is any change in the date of ID- UL- Fitre, ID-UZ- ZOHA, Maharam, Fathe- Daaz-Daham, Sabe-Barat depending upon the sighting of the moon, holidays will be declared by separate order for the date on which the festival would be actually observed in lieu of the date originally notified as holiday for this festival.

3) If many happen that the change of the date of the above occasions has to be notified at a very short notice.

In such situation announcement would be made through TV/A.I.R./Newspaper and The head of the department/ offices of the ULB take action according to such announcement without waiting for a formal order, about the change of date.

No separate circular will be issued in respect of above mentioned holidays during the year 2013.
